CONDITIONS ON WHICH STAMPS ARE RECEIVED FOR EXAMINATION

Every reasonable care is taken of specimens sent in for examination, but they are received and will be dealt with subject to these conditions, and in particular, the stipulations set out below, and any person sending in specimens shall be bound by the same and all things theretofore done by Committee in accordance with the same.

The stipulations are as follows:

1. The Committee shall be at liberty at their sole discretion to forward any specimens received by them to any expert (whether residing in Great Britain or abroad) for his examination thereof and observations thereon.
- 2(a) 'Neither the Society nor any member of the Committee or assistant(s) the Committee shall be in any way liable to the owners or any other person interested for loss or damage to the specimen(s).

However, if such loss or damage is caused by the Society or any member of the Committee or assistant(s) to the Committee's negligence, the Society or any member of the Committee or assistant(s) to the Committee's liability for such loss or damage shall be limited to a maximum of £1000.'

- 2(b) 'The Society or any member of Committee or assistant(s) to the Committee shall not be liable to the owners or any other person interested for any consequential loss, however arising.'
3. Items will be photocopied, photographed and may be subject to Ultra-Violet and/or Infra-Red light during examination.
4. In these conditions the singular shall include the plural, the masculine gender shall include the feminine, and any reference to a person shall include a corporation, firm, or two or more individuals of either sex.
